Mayor Turbeville called the meeting to order at 6:30pm and asked Patrick Goodwin to have the invocation.

Mayor Turbeville entertained a motion to adopt the printed agenda .. Councilman Newsome moved with Councilman McElveen to adopt the agenda as printed. Motion passed.

Mayor Turbeville called for a motion concerning the adoption of the minutes from the July 12, 2011 Regular Town Council Meeting & the Called Town Council Meeting of July 28, 2011. Councilman Newsome moved with Councilman McElveen seconding the motion that the minutes be approved. Motion passed.
