TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

September 13, 2011

Mayor Turbeville called the meeting to order at 6:30pm and asked Patrick Goodwin to have the invocation.

Mayor Turbeville entertained a motion to adopt the printed agenda . Councilman Newsome moved with Councilwoman Smith to adopt the agenda as printed. Motion passed.

Mayor Turbeville called for a motion concerning the adoption of the minutes from the August 9, 2011 Regular Town Council Meeting. Councilwoman Smith moved with Councilman Newsome seconding the motion that the minutes be approved. Motion passed.

Mayor Turbeville welcomed all of our guests to the council meeting and called for Public Participation. Having no public participation, the Mayor moved on to the next item on the agenda.

Mayor Turbeville called for the Second & Final Reading of Ordinance 2011-12 - Dissolution of Municipal Election Commission. Councilman Newsome moved with Councilwoman Smith seconding the motion to approve Ordinance 2011-12.

Mayor Turbeville then called for the various departmental reports:

- **Parks & Recreation** – Councilman Newsome reported Fall Football; Tackle & Tag & Cheerleading had begun practices. The Town has received a Grant for fencing on the ball fields and Ike was working on grant process.
- **Water/Sewer** – Ellis Evans reported in Councilman McElveen’s absence that everything was going well. Grass being cut and daily work was going well.
- **Police** –Councilwoman Smith deferred to Chief Jones for reports from the Police Department. He reported nothing new at this time.
- **Streets & Beautification** –Councilman Green was not present . Mayor Turbeville reported the Town was waiting on bids to be received on Phase 7.

Administrator Edge called attention to her written report and gave updates on the different Grants.

49 PARD Grant opened bids on fencing on Monday and rebids were taken today. Palmetto Pride
50 Tree Grant due September 15, 2011. Pick up date for trees in October. CDBG Grant – Powell
51 Neighborhood Grant Bids were opened September 9, 2011 at the Santee Lynches Office. Hill
52 Engineering has been recommended as the engineers for this project. A motion was made by
53 Councilwoman Smith with Councilman Newsome seconding the motion to accept Hill
54 Engineering LLC for the engineers on this project. Motion passed.
